Scope	Project-intake guidance for curtain-track geometry, route, mounting, opening, power coordination and drawing review.

It provides a coordination framework; it does not publish supplier specifications, private project values, customer records, copied source graphics, or product-performance guarantees.

HOW TO USE THIS PACK

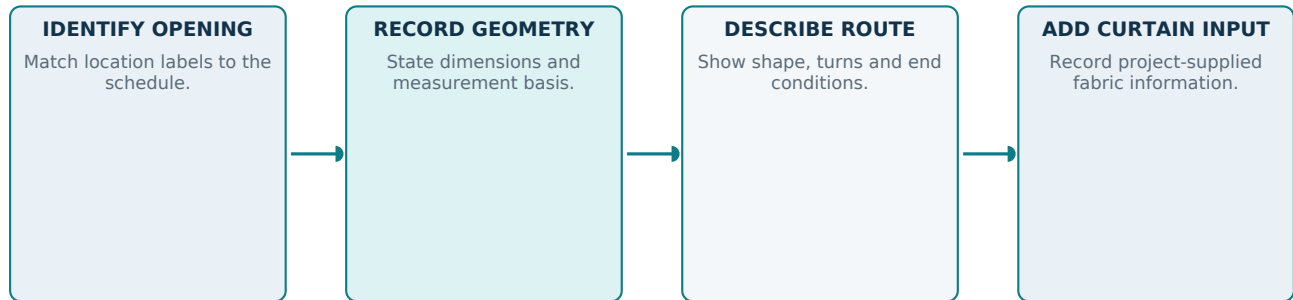
STEP	ACTION	OUTPUT
01	Record	Complete only known project inputs and retain the drawing revision reference.
02	Coordinate	Separate geometry, product, electrical, controls and responsibility questions.
03	Review	Bind selections to an approved project-specific drawing or submittal.
04	Submit	Use the project route below for Saiwenna review and quotation preparation.

Selection boundary Use this guide to prepare and coordinate project inputs. Final dimensions, equipment, interfaces and commercial terms remain subject to project review.

01 / PROJECT GEOMETRY

Geometry and route

Start with the project drawing. Keep every opening tied to one location label, one measurement basis and one route description.

Required geometry inputs

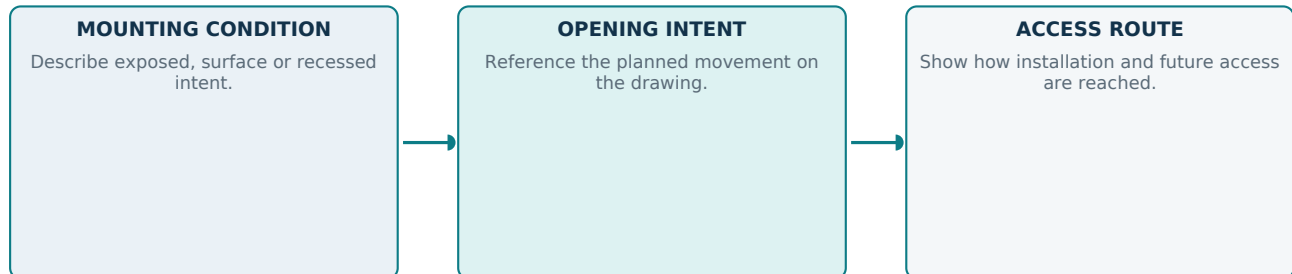
BUYER INPUT	WHAT TO RECORD
Location identifiers	Use the project's floor, room and opening labels consistently across drawings and schedules.
Opening geometry	Record the project dimensions and measurement basis for each identified opening.
Track route or shape	Show the planned route, turns, junctions and end conditions on the referenced drawing.
Curtain fabric, weight and fullness	Record the selected fabric information and fullness intent supplied by the project team.

Geometry gate Do not consolidate openings that have different routes, mounting conditions, fabrics or opening intent.

02 / PHYSICAL COORDINATION

Mounting and opening

Define the surrounding condition and the intended movement before equipment selection. Record access as part of the design, not as a later assumption.



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BUYER INPUT	WHAT TO RECORD
Mounting condition	State whether the design intent is exposed, surface-mounted or recessed and identify surrounding constraints.
Opening intent	Record the required movement or opening intent using the project drawing as the reference.
Access and maintenance	Record the proposed access route and the party that will maintain the finished installation.

Coordination prompts

NO.	CHECK BEFORE SUBMISSION	STATUS
01	The drawing identifies the substrate and surrounding finish condition.	REVIEW
02	The route, ends and movement intent use the same orientation reference.	REVIEW
03	The proposed access path is not blocked by adjacent work.	REVIEW
04	Unresolved site conditions are marked for project review.	REVIEW

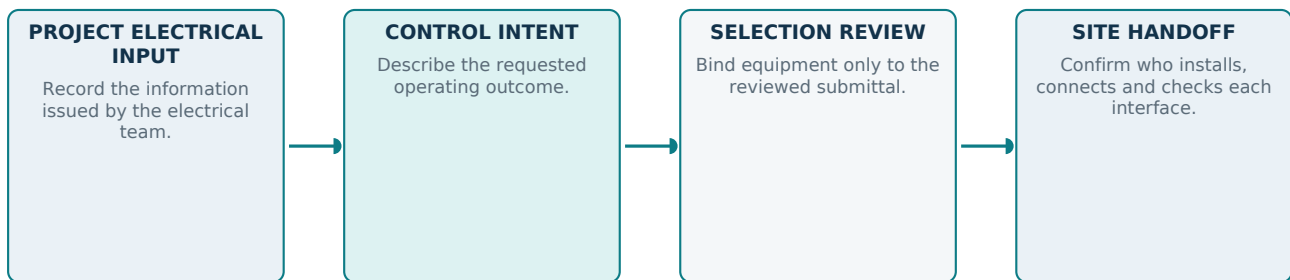
Drawing rule A conceptual route is not an installation drawing. Submit the current drawing revision for coordinated review.

03 / INTERFACES

Power coordination

Keep electrical inputs, control intent, drive-selection inputs and installation responsibility visible as separate project decisions.

BUYER INPUT	WHAT TO RECORD
Power supply inputs	Record the project power information provided by the electrical team; do not infer equipment suitability.
Cable route and power point	Mark proposed cable routes, handoff points and power-point locations on the coordinated drawing.
Control requirement and protocol	Describe the requested control outcome and any project protocol named by the controls team.
Drive selection inputs	Record the requested drive position and selection inputs; leave final equipment fields for project review.
Installation responsibility	Assign who prepares, installs, connects, tests, approves and maintains each project interface.

Interface gate

Do not infer equipment suitability from a power or control label alone. The project team must reconcile all interface inputs together.

04 / SUBMISSION

Drawing checklist

Package the coordinated inputs so each opening can be reviewed without relying on private source files or unstated assumptions.

BUYER INPUT	WHAT TO RECORD
Drawing revision reference	Identify the drawing issue and revision that the submission is based on.
Approval and sample submittal	List the samples, finishes and project submittals that require review before release.
Project type	Describe the project context so the submission can be organized around the buyer's task.
Project stage	Identify whether the request is at concept, design, tender, approval or order-preparation stage.
Buyer role	State the role coordinating the request so questions can be routed to the correct project discipline.
Quantity	Provide the scheduled quantity by opening or item group; do not combine unlike configurations.

NO.	CHECK BEFORE SUBMISSION	STATUS
01	Location identifiers reconcile between the drawing and opening schedule.	REVIEW
02	Geometry, route, mounting and opening intent are shown together.	REVIEW
03	Power, cable route and control intent are recorded as project inputs.	REVIEW
04	The drawing issue and revision are named on every submission page.	REVIEW
05	Open questions and responsibility owners are explicit.	REVIEW

BUYER INPUT	WHAT TO RECORD
Project destination	State the destination needed for document, delivery and project-coordination review.
Delivery, Incoterm and timing	State the destination basis, requested trade term and project timing for quotation review.
Packing and label grouping	Describe how finished items should be grouped and identified for site receipt.
